



George Jenkins High School Dress Code

2018-19



In order to ensure an orderly learning environment where all students understand and demonstrate respect for themselves and others, all students are responsible for familiarizing themselves and complying with dress code expectations. These expectations include:

- 1) **Shirts and blouses:** Shirts and blouses shall be of appropriate size, shall have a strap larger than a spaghetti strap, and shall not reveal the midriff. Sleeveless athletic shirts are not allowed.
- 2) **Pants:** Pants shall be worn at, not below, the waist and shall not have any holes that expose undergarments or body parts in an indecent manner.
- 3) **Shorts:** Shorts shall be worn at, not below, the waist, shall be of appropriate length, and shall not reveal undergarments or body parts in an indecent manner.

Unacceptable Attire: Students are not allowed to wear any attire (including bandanas) or markings that are offensive, suggestive, disruptive, or indecent, such as:

- 1) Clothing associated with gangs.
- 2) Clothing encouraging the use of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or violence.
- 3) Clothing associated with discrimination on the basis of age, color, handicap, national origin, marital status, race, religion, or sex.
- 4) Clothing exposing the torso or upper thighs such as see-through garments, mini-skirts or mini-dresses, halters, backless dresses, tube tops or tank tops without over-blouses or shirts, spaghetti strap garments without over-blouses or shirts, bare midriff outfits, or shirts or blouses tied at the midriff.
- 5) Clothing not properly fastened or with tears that expose undergarments or body parts in an indecent manner.
- 6) Clothing or outer garments traditionally designed as undergarments such as boxer shorts, bloomers, tights, hosiery, and sleepwear.
- 7) Clothing or footwear that is construed by the principal or designee as hazardous or dangerous to the health of the student or others.
- 8) Overalls- any bibbed pants or shorts (with an inseam).
- 9) Trench Coats
- 10) Hooded sweatshirts are acceptable but hoods may not be worn during school hours.
- 11) Hats may not be worn when inside the buildings.

**In addition to the guidelines described above, all students must wear student identification badges at all times around the neck area when on school grounds. Please familiarize yourself with our Student ID Policy.
