

Spring 2019 Test Score Release

Scores from the Spring 2019 State Assessments will be released to FDOE by June 28, 2019. Schools will be closed July 1 – 5. We will have staff available July 8 and 9 to advise you by phone if your student Passed or Did Not Pass the FSA ELA 10th grade test or any of the End of Course exams (Algebra, Geometry, Biology, and US History). We will not provide actual test scores at this time. Hard copy score reports will be delivered to the schools in August.

If your student missed taking any of the EOCs this Spring or did not pass and wants to retake it, you may come to the school and complete a Summer EOC registration form. Since summer testing starts on Monday July 15 the deadline to complete this form will be July 10th.

A passing score on the Algebra EOC is required for graduation. Other ways of meeting this requirement is receiving a score of 16 on the Math Section of the ACT, 420 on the SAT Math, or 430 on the Math Section of the PSAT. The PSAT will be given to all first time 10th graders on October 16, 2019 free of charge. For students who entered 9th grade in School Year 17-18 or prior may also use a PERT Math test score of 97.

If you register for the Algebra EOC, and your first year in 9th grade is 17-18 or earlier, you will be given the PERT test on Monday July 15th. If you achieve a score of 97 you will not have to take the Algebra EOC.

Please note, all EOCs will be offered in September, December, and May of the next school year in the event you are not able to come this summer.

The tentative schedule for Summer Testing is as follows:

July 15 at 1:00 p.m.: PERT Math test (must have registered for the Algebra EOC)

July 16 at 8:00 a.m.: Algebra or Geometry EOC (there are two 90 minute sessions that will be completed on this day)

July 17 at 8:00 a.m.: Variety Day for those needing more than one test

July 18 at 8:00 a.m.: Biology or US History EOC

You may call the school on July 8 and 9 to find out if your student passed or not. Again, actual scores will not be provided at this time.
