You must submit a minimum 500 word essay on the following topic: "What safety features can be added to cars to cut down on injuries when a car crash occurs?"
Directing Change Student Film Contest	3/01/17	Ages 14-25						Up to 500	The Directing Change Student Film Contest is open to students between the ages of 14 and 25. You must submit a film of no more than 60 seconds related to mental health and/or suicide prevention in order to be considered for this award.
College Scholarship Contest	4/17/17	12						2,500	The College Scholarship Contest is available to students enrolled in a college or university or planning to enroll as a freshman for the 2017-2018 academic year. You must be in good academic standing and submit an essay.

You must create a form of social awareness that inspires other students to focus on Looking Twice for Motorcycle Safety to qualify for this award. This can be a video, artwork, essay or anything that would engage other students to focus on safe driving. Student must have a valid driver's license.

You must submit an essay of between 1,000 and 2,000 words on why green home improvement is important in today's world in order to be considered for this award.
