



George Jenkins High School Student Identification Badge Policy 2018-19



Student identification badges will be provided to secondary students district-wide in an effort to ensure the safety and security of students and staff. Students must wear the ID badge at all times around the neck area when on school grounds.

Student identification badges will be provided to all George Jenkins High School students at no cost, within the first **three weeks** of the school year.

- Students may obtain their student identification badge at Orientation or during lunch for the first three weeks of the school year.
- Students will also be provided a lanyard with a break-away safety clasp at no cost.
 - Lanyards are individualized based on the year of the students' graduating class.

By the end of the third week of school, students are expected to wear their school-issued student identification badge at all times around the neck area when on school grounds.

- 1) Student identification badges must be worn around the neck on a lanyard or clipped to the collar.
- 2) ID Badges are considered a part of the George Jenkins High School dress code and must be worn throughout the entire school day.
- 3) Students are required to show their ID when requested by a staff member.
- 4) Students without their student identification badge will be referred to the office to have a replacement student identification badge made.
 - Once a new badge is made, students will be sent back to class.
 - Students will be charged a fee for each replacement identification badge.
